As India continues a ceaseless struggle against the pandemic and marches towards the triumph of humanity, Bharati Vidyapeeth Institute of Technology, Navi Mumbai expresses its solidarity by initiating a step further in this regard.



BVIT, after a long hiatus of almost 20 months, opens the portals of the college for the First Year batch of students for attending class in person. The teaching learning process, which had been Online since April 2020, resumed its Offline mode on Wednesday 10th November 2021 with almost 240 students joining the Institute. This moment was celebrated by greeting pupils with roses, symbolically, a bed of roses awaiting their future.



In adherence to all Govt. SOPs and Protocols, the entire premises was sanitized a day in advance. The placing of sanitizers at the entrance and other strategic points and soap dispensers in the washroom was also ensured. During entry, they were briefed to stand singularly on the staircase at the right and left ends alternately. Seating arrangement was made keeping social distancing in mind, single student was allowed to occupy one bench, at alternate ends in a zigzag manner. It was also ensured that no entry was allowed without ID Card and proper use of mask and sanitizer.
