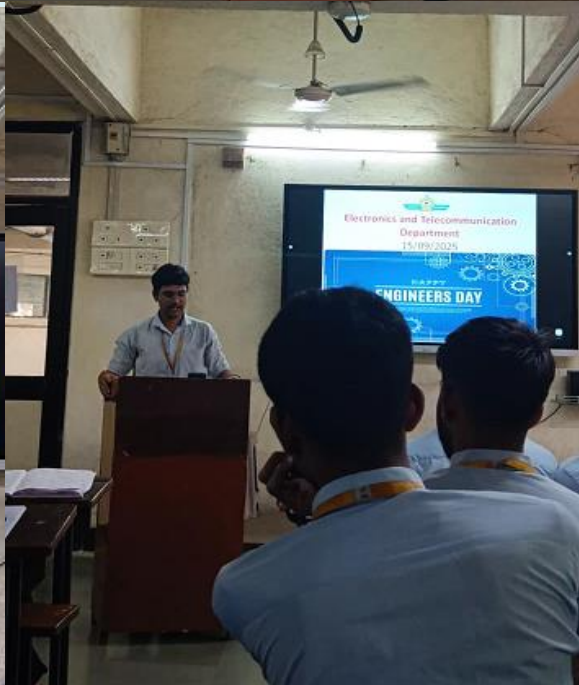
ENGINEERS DAY

INDUSTRIAL VISIT

ALL INDIA RADIO (17/09/2025)

On **17th September 2025**, the second-year students of the Electronics and Telecommunication Department had the valuable opportunity to visit **All India Radio (AIR), Churchgate**, accompanied by their guides **Mrs. Sulekha Chatterjee , Mr.Kalyan , and Mr. Solanki** . The visit aimed to provide the students with firsthand exposure to the practical aspects of radio broadcasting and the various electronic and telecommunication technologies involved. Upon arrival, the students were welcomed by AIR officials who briefed them about the history, significance, and operations of the national broadcaster.

The group was divided into two groups of 34 students and 1 staff member in each group then taken on a detailed tour of the studios where live programs were being recorded and transmitted, allowing the students to witness the entire broadcasting process. They were introduced to the technical infrastructure, including transmitters, modulators, mixers, and antenna systems, and learned about the principles of amplitude modulation (AM) and frequency modulation (FM) as applied in radio transmissions. The students also visited the control room, where engineers monitor and control the quality and continuity of the broadcast signal. This experience enabled them to understand signal processing, wave propagation, and the maintenance of electronic equipment critical to smooth broadcasting. During the interactive Q&A session, the students asked insightful questions related to RF engineering, signal clarity, and technical challenges faced in the field, which were addressed by the experts.

Overall, the visit was a comprehensive learning experience that effectively connected the theoretical knowledge gained in the classroom with real-world applications, enhancing the students' understanding of communication technologies and inspiring them for their future careers in electronics and telecommunication.





REPORT ON HIV/AIDS AWARENESS PROGRAM
