- To address the specific needs and challenges of the library in relation to KOHA implementation.

## Workshop Content

The workshop covered the following key areas:

- **Refresher on KOHA LIMS** : Overview of the software, its advanced features, and benefits.
- **Acquisition Module**: Ordering, receiving, and processing library materials.
- **Serials Management**: Managing subscriptions, issues, and binding.
- **Cataloguing and Classification**: Creating and managing bibliographic records, subject headings, and classification schemes.



- **Circulation Module:** Issuing, renewing, and returning books, managing overdue fines, and generating circulation reports.
- **OPAC (Online Public Access Catalogue):** Customizing the OPAC for user-friendly interface.
- **Reporting and Statistics:** Generating reports for NAAC criteria, including collection analysis, circulation statistics, and user statistics.
- **NAAC Compliance:** Discussing the specific requirements of NAAC, regarding library management systems and how KOHA can address them.

## Methodology

The workshop adopted a blended learning approach, combining theoretical inputs with hands-on exercises. Participants were provided with step-by-step instructions and opportunities to practice on the KOHA system. Experienced trainers conducted the sessions, providing expert guidance and support.

## Conclusion

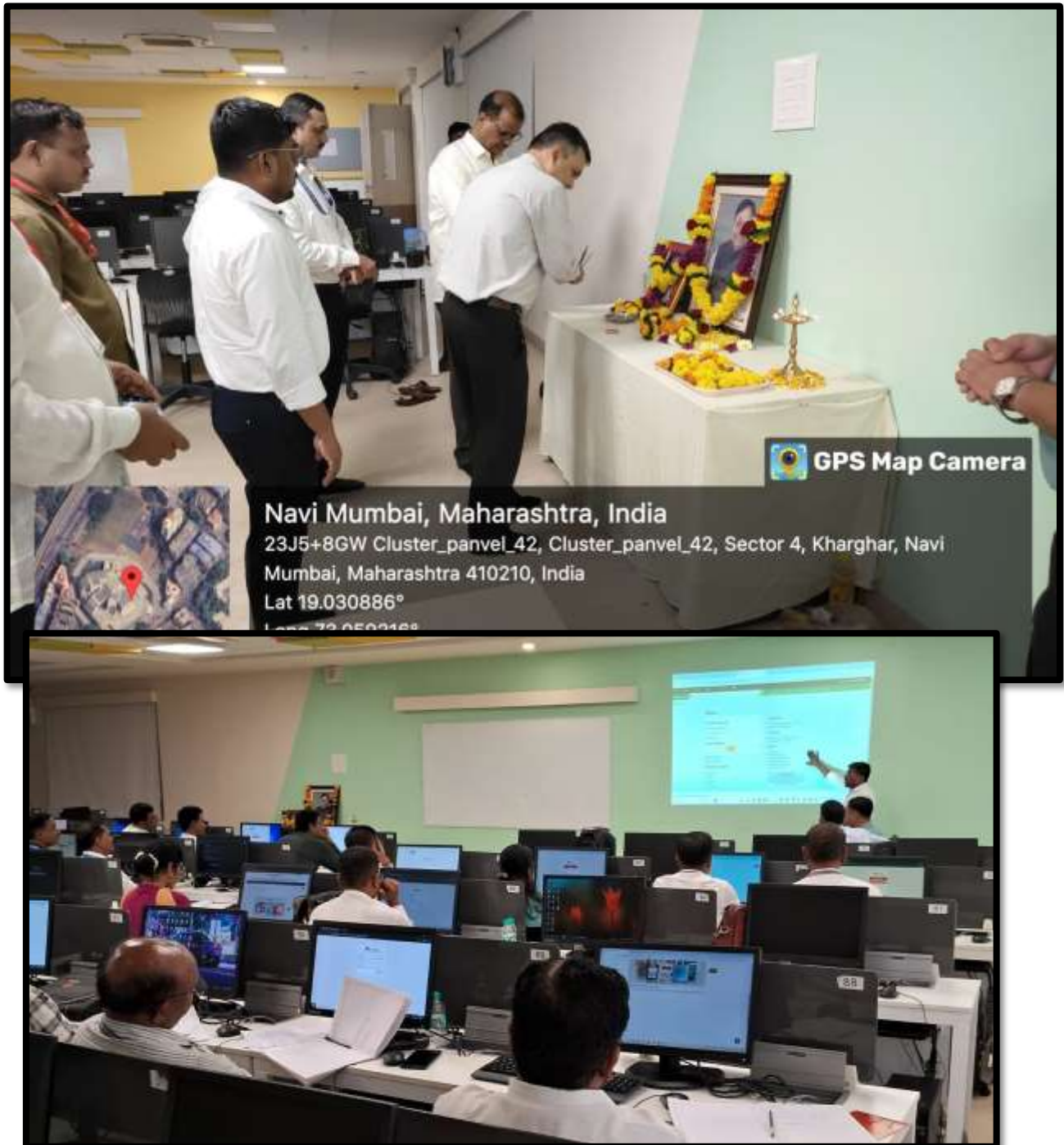

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

BETWEEN

**Bharati Vidyapeeth Deemed University Dental College and Hospital**

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter called as the 'MOU') is entered into on this 14<sup>th</sup> day of February 2024 by and between. **Bharati Vidyapeeth Institute of Technology Navi Mumbai**, the First Party represented herein by its **Principal**, **Bharati Vidyapeeth Deemed University Dental College and Hospital**, the Second party, and represented herein by its **Principal**

WHEREAS:

A) First Party is a Higher Educational Institution named: **Bharati Vidyapeeth Institute of Technology Navi Mumbai** called as **BVIT** is well established polytechnic imparting diploma education.

B) Established in 2005, **Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University)'s Dental College and Hospital, Navi Mumbai**, is a premier institution providing high-quality dental education and healthcare services. The college offers undergraduate (BDS), postgraduate (MDS), and doctoral programmes aimed at developing proficient dental professionals.

C) **Bharati Vidyapeeth, Pune** is parent organization of both parties.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

### 1. Purpose of MoU

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish co-operation.
- 1.2 Medical facilities at **BVDUDCH** will be made available to students and staff members of **BVIT**.
- 1.3 In addition to medical facilities, oral healthcare services facilities at **BVDUDCH** will be made available to students and staff members of **BVIT**.

### 2. Implementation of MoU

- 2.1 Service of **MBBS doctors** available at **BVDUDCH** will be provided to the students and staff of **BVIT** as and when required.
- 2.2 Oral healthcare services available at **BVDUDCH** will be provided to the students and staff of **BVIT** as and when required.
- 2.3 **BVIT** can display name and mobile number of doctor given by **BVDUDCH** at its medical room.
- 2.4 **BVDUDCH** will permit use of its vehicle to carry students in the nearby hospital in case of emergency.

2.5 Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, and permissions, of whatsoever nature required.

### 3. Validity of MOU

3.1 This Agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms.

4. BVDUDCH will provide additional charges deductions (Discount) for oral healthcare services with respect to original charges for staff and students of BVIT Navi Mumbai:

- a) All routine dental OPD and consultation will be provided FREE OF COST
- b) All dental treatment services will be provided at 50% discount (under 500/-) with respect to original charges.
- c) All dental treatment services will be provided at 30% discount (under 3000/-) with respect to original charges.
- d) 30% discount on Fixed orthodontic treatment and dental implants without prosthesis
- e) Regular dental diagnostic camps organized for BVIT Navi Mumbai will be free of cost.
- f) All the above-mentioned oral healthcare services will be provided to the staff and students of BVIT Navi Mumbai on production of identity card of college or letter from concerned authorities or referral slip by BVDUDCH.
